


# North Carolina Board of Architecture Seal Facsimiles



## Individual Seal

The seal may be either an embossed circular seal or a rubber stamp consisting of two concentric circles.


The diameter of the outer circle should be 1.5".

The diameter of the inner circle should be 1".

The area between the two circles shall contain the licensee's name as on file with the Board at the top and his/her place of business city and state at the bottom.

The inner circle shall contain the words "Registered Architect" at the top and "North Carolina" at the bottom, with the license number in the center.

## Firm Seal (Professional Corporation or PLLC)

The seal may be either an embossed circular seal or a rubber stamp consisting of two concentric circles.

The diameter of the outer circle should be 1.5".

The diameter of the inner circle should be 1".

The area between the two circles shall contain the firm name at the top and place of business city and state at the bottom.

The inner circle shall contain the words "Registered Architectural Corporation" at the top\*\* and "North Carolina" shall be along the bottom.

The inner circle shall contain the firm's North Carolina registration number.

**\*\* Note that a Professional Limited Liability Company should use "Registered Architectural Company".**
