Board Members Cheryl Walker and Chris Brasier and I along with Executive Director Cathe Evans were honored to attend the Southern Conference of NCARB Educator's Conference. The conference was held in Atlanta on February 11, 2012.

Approximately twenty-seven educators represented architecture schools throughout the southern region including Robin Abrams and Marvin Malecha from NC State University College of Design/School of Architecture and Christopher Jarret from University of North Carolina – Charlotte School of Architecture. From our neighboring state South Carolina – Kate Schwennsen, Chair of the Clemson School of Architecture was in attendance.

The Conference featured the 2011 NCARB Prize Winners Keith and Marie Zawistowski, a husband and wife team who are both Assistant Professors of Practice at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and University. Virginia Tech captured the grand prize for engaging students in the often "mundane" subject of professional practice by introducing it as a design problem—an innovative means to make the subject relevant to students. The highly interactive academic course exposed architecture students to real and virtual aspects of running their own firms. Other featured speakers were Janice Wittschiebe, Principle of <u>Richard Wittschiebe</u> <u>Hand</u>, and staff member and Natalie Martinez, AIA. Richard Wittschiebe Hand is the Atlanta firm that won the AIA IDP Outstanding Firm Award winner. As a young intern Martinez found the RWH IDP mentoring to be an incredible asset to her career. The principles at RWH were serious and dedicated to enhancing the IDP experience and encourage completion of the ARE with such incentives as pay upgrades, bonuses and social functions. She encouraged her supervisors to submit their IDP program for the AIA award and they won. Wittschiebe detailed the firm's mission indicating that design is a result of the collaborative effort between the client, the users, the consultants and the architect – including the valuable intern. 

Expired license listing – In the back of the newsletter you will find a list of firms whose North Carolina firm license to practice architecture expired on December 31, 2011. This list includes firms that for various reasons, chose not to renew and notified the Board office. If you find your firm on the list and you are currently practicing architecture in this State, you may be in violation of Board rules and laws and may be subject to disciplinary action. And now for something completely different....

Can you pass the Board of Architecture Rules and Laws Exam?

Below are a few questions from the Board rules and laws exam. If you are struggling with the answers it might be time to brush up on 21 NCAC 02. a.k.a. "the rules" and G. S. 83A a.k.a. "the laws".

- 1. True or False: In order to protect the public health, safety and welfare, the Board can adopt rules that prohibit advertising.
- 2. The rules and laws governing corporate practice:
- a. Do not apply to out-of-state corporations
- b. Do not require out-of-state corporations to acquire a corporate license provided the person in charge holds an individual license in any state.

Webcast for IDP 2.0 Webinar Now Available

Washington DC—In preparation for the rollover to the Intern Development Program (IDP) 2.0 on 3 April 2012, NCARB hosted two webinars on upcoming changes to IDP for interns, supervisors, and mentors. Assistant Director, IDP Nick Serfass explains the new experience categories, areas, and settings and how current experience will rollover to IDP 2.0.

Announced in 2009, IDP 2.0 is the most significant update to the Intern Development Program (IDP) since its inception in the 1970s. Using the 2007 Practice Analysis of Architecture as a guide, the program requirements are being updated to more closely align with the current practice of architecture, to help ensure that interns acquire the comprehensive training that is essential for competent practice, and to make reporting experience fundamentally easier.

NCARB selected new vendors for the Architect Registration Examination®

enforcement report

Following is the Enforcement Report for the period September 1, 2011 through February 15, 2012. The Board is not bound by precedence in matters of disciplinary action. It is the prerogative of the Board to be conservative in its review of cases and to enforce the rules and laws with sanctions and civil penalties as allowed by law. You may request a copy of the entire order by sending an email to <u>cathe@ncbarch.org</u> be sure to include the case number with your request.

Consent Order

Case 904 - Respondent Gray Stout failed to renew his license to practice architecture but continued to practice architecture. Respondent paid a Civil Penalty in the amount of \$500 as well as reimbursing the Board for administrative costs associated with the case.

Letter of Caution

The Board of Architecture issued one Letter of Caution to an architect.

<u>Letter of Warning</u>

The Board of Architecture issued a Letter of Warning to Jeff Sanderson of Whitney Blair Construction for non-licensed use of 'architecture'.

Dismissed/Unfounded/No Action

The Board of architecture dismissed eleven cases as unfounded or without prejudice or no action. These matters were investigated, however, there was no evidence to demonstrate a violation of Board rules and laws.

Cease and Desist Orders

The Board issued one Cease and Desist Order to Daniel Bureau for infringing on the title 'architect' by forming a company using the name "Architexz". Mr. Bureau has renamed his company.

A note on Board enforcement and jurisdiction.

In the past year or so, the Professional Standards Committee of the Board has received an increase in complaints involving contractual matters between architects and their clients as well employment matters between architectural firms and former employees. The Board of Architecture has jurisdiction pursuant to North Carolina General Statute §83A-15 and 21 NCAC 02 .0208, 21 NCAC 02 .0209 and 21 NCAC 02 .210 to receive and investigate complaints involving dishonest conduct, incompetence and unprofessional conduct. This Board does not have the statutory authority to discipline architects regarding complaints involving contract disagreements or allegations of ordinary negligence, nor can the Board mediate these situations.


